Katie Wardrobe is a qualified teacher who enjoys helping people of all skill levels get the most out of music software programs. She runs her own business - Midnight Music - which specializes in training music educators and students, and she also runs sessions for composers, songwriters and arrangers. In 2010 Katie set up a tutorials and tips site to support users of MuseScore - free open-source notation software - and in 2011 she released an ebook titled *MuseScore: The Essential Beginner's Guide*.

Katie has worked in a variety of music and education-related workplaces, including Sibelius Australia and Orchestra Victoria. In 2011 she was the Project Manager of the Soundhouse Alliance's Music Technology in Education Conference and she has presented at more than 20 other conferences and events. Katie has worked as a freelance copyist, music arranger and transcriber for more than 20 years and is an Executive member of the Music Arrangers Guild of Australia. She also sings in (and directs) a 5-voice a cappella group called Quintessential.
